#### **Program Duration**



- 1. March 2026–July 2026 (Spring Semester)
- 2. March 2026–January 2027 (Spring & Fall Semesters) The starting time of studying in China should not be later than August 31, 2026.

- 2. Applicants should have completed high school diploma or above and be under 45 years of age.
- 3. Please confirm you are from an overseas partner institution of the China Link Scholarship program by the time of application and throughout the proposed stay in China.

- 3. XJTU will notify applicants of scholarship award decisions based on the CSC's review results.



# **Application Documents** for XJTU online Application



- 1. Scanned copy of valid ordinary passport
- 2. Completed Physical Examination Record for Foreigners and required Blood Test Report

The physical examination must cover ALL the items listed in the form. (Download at http://sie.xjtu.edu.cn/en /2.pdf and fill in English.) The forms with incomplete records or without the suggestion and signature of the attending physician, an official cross-edge stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicant are invalid. Please select the appropriate time to take a physical examination as the result is valid for only 6 months.

- 3. Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship which would be automatically generated after completing CSC online application.
- 4. Non-criminal Record within the validity period.
- 5. Certificate of enrollment from your current university.
- Original and notarized copies of transcripts. The transcript should be issued and stamped by the Academic Affairs Office or the relevant student administration department of the school.
- 7. Applicants are required to provide a study plan:
  Personal Statement or Research Proposal in Chinese or
  English, at least 500 words.
- 8. Language Proficiency Certificate (IELTS 6.0, TOEFL 80, or Duolingo English Test 110 (or above)) or English-taught degree certificate document issued by the current/previous academic institution.
- 9. Papers or Articles Published (optional)
- 10. Other Supporting Documents (optional)
